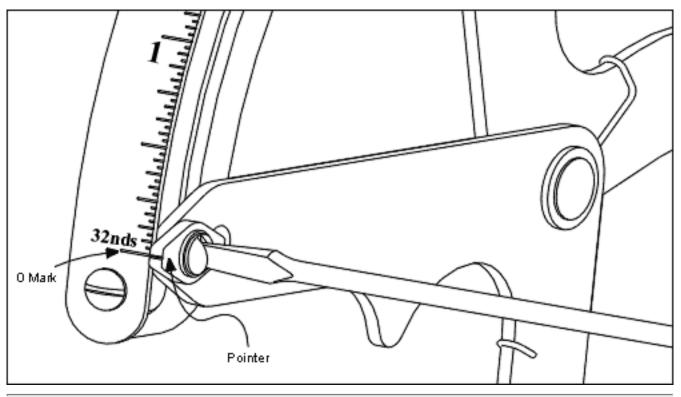
## **Veritas® Direct-Reading Caliper**

## (#05N39.01)

The Veritas® direct-reading caliper comes calibrated, ready for use. When in the closed position, the tips touch each other and the engraved line on the pointer is aligned with the **0** mark on the scale.

Should the direct-reading caliper ever need to be recalibrated (due to wear or damage to a tip), follow the procedure below.

- 1. If necessary, the damaged tip may be lightly reground. Check that there is no debris between the tips and ensure that the tips are in proper contact when in the closed position.
- 2. Use a small slot screwdriver to just loosen the screw that holds the pointer; a 1/4 turn should be adequate.
- 3. Rotate the pointer until the engraved line is aligned with the **0** mark on the scale.
- 4. Hold the pointer in position and tighten the screw.
